As required by our constitution, each year a number of ABTC Trustees have to stand down at the AGM. And, if they want to continue on the Board of Trustees, stand for re-election.

This is also the opportunity for anyone who would like to join the Board to stand for election.

Specifically – Animal Behaviour and Training Council Trustees – are responsible for the day to day running of the Council supported by our paid Secretariat. They help develop the strategies to take the charity forward and answer queries. Each Trustee also has a role – as an Officer (all Officers are Trustees) and/or on a committee. We currently have committees for Membership Applications, Practitioner Assessments, Programme Recognition, General Purpose and Finance Committee, Social Media, Events, Equines, Cats, APEL Assessments, Fund-raising, UKAS Application and Diversity, Equity and Inclusion.
